Undertaking a local history study

The sorts of questions/ingredients to put into a medium term plan are:

What is this 'place'?

Where is this place? What questions do we want to ask about this place? E.g.

- When was it built/made/developed etc?
- Who lived/worshipped/shopped/worked/attended/played etc. here?
- How has it changed over time?

HOW WILL WE FIND OUT? WHAT CLUES ARE THERE?

How does this place fit into the locality? To London? What do we think is interesting about this place?

Sources), documents, archival material (e.g. directories, census returns, log book, pictures/photos/film)
