

- 16th century timber-framed, but much altered
- 2 c.1860
- Back half 16th century timber-framed; front half late 19th century
- 4 18th century; working smithy until 1940s
- Early 19th century front; rear earlier
- Late 19th century beyond is a 17th-century building, now timber-clad 14 19th century replacement for 16th century building
- Early 19th century
- 8 Late 19th century

- 9 18th century, but much altered
- 10 17th century, rebuilt in the 18th century
- 11 Late 17th century (date 1675 over main door)
- 12 Gothic Revival, 19th century; originally bakery and coal depot
- 13 Possibly 17th century, but much altered
- 15 Parts are Norman, others later medieval or Tudor, the cupola on the tower is Georgian
- 16 Early 15th century, 192 feet long and 39 feet wide, the largest barn in Middlesex
