

Bank Four

Developed by Derek Beddow and other Bradford colleagues at their collaborative workshop in March 2007. Is 'bank four' Bradford dialect for 'connect4'? and how far south/north/west does this expression go? They have provided a transliterated version in Punjabi, and we are planning to add transliterated versions in other languages. Can you help or your students? There are no fixed rules about transliteration; in fact differences of opinion will improve discussion about language difference and language change. Just provide a version that is as close as you think you can get using regular English phonemes: ie not 'ghoti' for 'fish'! Send them in 'word' or on the back of a postcard and I'll add them to the activity. If you can produce transliterations for other collaborative maths activities then you will store up special CLP brownie points. Now that the activity is available sound enabled from <www.mantralingua.com> you can add numbers, as well as mores and lesses in any language

A collaborative game for 2-4 players to reinforce the rapid recall of addition and subtraction of 2/5/10 to numbers up to 100.

Language development:

'more than' '10 more than 10 is 20'

'less than' '5 less than 20 is 15'

Transliterated version in Punjabi also included

How to Play:

2 sets are 30 cards are placed face down on the table: different colour set for each team.

Team take turns to place one card on the board.

The player/s who can 'bank' four in a row (vertical/diagonal/horizontal) are the winners.
