# Why Minibooks?

Excellent for sharing and comparing in small groups.

Good practice in accurate folding.

Small amounts to write and to read.

Can be used for information gap activities. Four books with different information.

Two different books can be created on one sheet of A4 paper

Portable, easily stored and very inexpensive.

Larger versions can be made on A3 or tinier on A5

Good for mini art work.

Easy to make versions on the computer

Mini biographies e.g. Henry VIII's six wives or rainforest animals

Summaries of longer books or stories.

Time lines for historical events. e.g. Our Viking dates. Jokes: turn the page tor the punchlines.

Story beginnings

Difficult words to spell or mini dictionaries for a topic

Diaries e.g. Wombat Diaries

#### Steps continued





Unfold completely and fold again lengthwise. Then wiggle the folds until the cut in the centre has opened up. Shape into a minibook. If you have folded accurately and thoroughly the book will form easily. Any inaccurate folding is multiplied when the book is folded.
