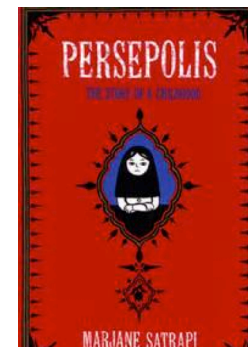


Reading and Writing Around The World
