There are five different documents. Each child receives ONE document which makes them a character: journalist, queen, king, Spanish sailor or English sailor. Some are easier to read than others so you may want to choose who receives what. Try to work it out so that the same numbers of each document are given out.

JOURNALISTS get together and plan an article - pictures, questions to each character, a 'line' and a headline etc.

OTHER CHARACTERS read their document and then introduce themselves to a different character from the same country. Spanish sailor meets Spanish king, English sailor meets English queen.

THE PAIR OF CHARACTERS then go to find a pair from the other country. Each character introduces the other side of their pair to the new pair and vice versa.

Then THE GROUP OF FOUR find a journalist, who collates all the information with the group helping them to write their article.
